**Summary:**

23/6/08 - History - slightly off yesterday but depressed today. Still eating/drinking, passing normal moist manure. quiet, alert, responsive, mucous membranes pink, capillary refill time 1s, heart rate 60, respiratory rate 50, sharp, shallow breathing, temperature 39, gut sounds present, chest clear, ventral oedema starting, scrotal oedema. Took blood and sent to QML. Gave 10ml bute intravenous. Passed nasogastric tube but no reflux. Rectal revealed small amount of moist manure. inguinal rings nad, intestine nad, could only get up to elbow. Ultrasound of abdomen and chest - nad. Attempted peritoneal tap but no fluid. Looking for feed. HEH

2pm-heart rate 56, temperature 38.0

5:15pm - heart rate 76, temperature 37.6, but bright, alert, responsive, mucous membranes pink, capillary refill time 1s, eating all his feed. Treated with 45ml baytril intravenous, 50ml Penicillin intramuscular.

9PM - depressed, heart rate 64

24/6/08 - depressed, mucous membranes pink, capillary refill time 1 sec, heart rate 76, respiratory rate 24, slightly reduced gut sounds, temperature 39.6, maintain on hartmanns moderate drip, treated with 10ml bute intravenous and 50ml Penicillin intramuscular twice a day, 45ml baytril intravenous once a day. Ultrasound of chest and abdomen nad. Recta nad. Negative peritoneal tap. temperature 37, Removed 7 x 5L Hartmanns. Continue intravenous fluids on moderate drip. Took bloods and sent to QML. Treated with 60ml salsprim intravenous sid HEH

Collapsed in afternoon (5pm) unable to urinate, 10ml finadyne given 1ml xylase, catheterised bladder, unwilling to move. rectal nad

6:30pm collapsed, pale mucous membranes, pulmonary oedema frothing from nose, euthanased on humane grounds. HEH
