

Plant list

The following list provides a guideline to plant species that may be used in urban and small rural block environments. These species can replace large shade trees, such as African Mahogany along with other species that are colonised by Flying Foxes. There is no guarantee that flying fox colonies will not frequent these plant species however there is less chance that the flying foxes will stay in these trees for an extended period.

Trees

Albizia Lebbek	Albizia	10 - 15m	large spreading tree
Brachychiton Diversifolius	Kurrajong	7 - 5m	large, well formed tree, hairy seeds
Callatris Intratropica	Northern Cypress pine	15 - 18m	tall straight tree
Casuarina Cunninghaia	River She - Oak	10 - 20m	tall, slender branched tree, small woody cones
Casuarina Equisetifolia	Coastal She – Oak	10 - 20m	tall slender branched tree.
Gardenia Megasperma	Gardenia	3 - 6m	small tree/round crown
Grevillea Decurrens	Grevillea	3 - 5m	slender erect tree or shrub growth
Grevillea Heliosperma	Grevillea	5 - 10m	slender erect tree or shrub growth
Grevillea Pteridifolia	Grevillea	5 - 8m	slender erect tree or shrub growth
Leptospermum Longifolium	Weeping Tea Tree	3 - 5m	weeping branches. Note: seeks out water
Owenia Vernicosa	Owenia	4 - 12m	open round crown
Petalostigma Pubescens	Quinine Tree	3 - 6m	garden tree with orange woody fruit
Wodyetia Bifurcata	Foxtail Palm		tall palm
Livistona Humilis	Sand Palm	2 - 5m	slender palm
Livistona Inermis	Fan Palm	5 - 8m	slender palm
Chrysalidocarpus Lutescens	Golden Cane	2 - 4m	screening/hedging plant
Caryota Mitis	Clumping Fishtail	4 - 5m	screening

IMPORTANT – Do not plant large trees in proximity to or under powerlines. When planting trees be aware of the species, canopy size and height when it is fully grown.

Hibiscus species	Various	3 - 4m	can be pruned to shape, screening plant
Cycad species	Various	1 - 5m	screening plant
Grevillia species	Various	1 - 7m	screening/attract birds
